



Mission Trip Requirements

The following requirements are presented to assist you in your preparation for and involvement in a High School Ministry Mission Trip.

- Regular attendance at church worship services.
- Regular involvement in the High School Ministry. (A minimum of 50% attendance of all High School Ministry meetings and events during April-July – including Underground, LIFT, Merge, Elevations, RIOTs, retreats, activities, etc.).
- Involvement in other scheduled AWOLs (service projects) this year.
- Maintain the following journals:
 - Journal of each service with the following information: date of the service, topic of the message or Bible passage, notes or a completed outline, summation of how the message or teaching is to be applied to personal life – kept April-July.
 - Devotional Journal – involvement in personal devotions a minimum of 4 days each week—kept April-July.
 - Journal of Physical Fitness – kept April through July.
- Read at least one mission or evangelism oriented book.
- Choose at least one AUC missionary to maintain communication with through letters, e-mail, etc.
- Enlist a Prayer Team of at least seven people who will commit to praying for you regularly.
- Memorize the Plan of Salvation.
- Complete the “My Accountability Commitment” form and share it with your Small Group leader.
- Fulfillment of your financial support levels (including filling out the “Application for Financial Support”).
- “Interview” with the HSM Leadership Team and the Missionary Committee.
- Presence at the Commissioning Service prior to the mission trip.
- Attendance at all Mission Team Meetings and the Team Retreat prior to the trip.
- Say “thank you” to all financial supporters and praying friends.
- Write a brief (one page) report of your experience for the Christian Ed & Missionary Committees.



* Involvement in the HS Ministry and all three journals are expected to be kept from time of acceptance and up to the time of the trip, however, they will be looked at carefully from April through July. *
